

STANDARD HONORS WITH THE ELECTRONIC BUGLE

THREE PERSON DETAIL

The honor guard detail will arrive at a minimum of half hour prior to procession arrival at the cemetery or other predetermined location. The POIC will conduct a rehearsal of the honors to be performed. When the funeral coach arrives and the pallbearers remove the casket from the funeral coach, the POIC will call "Hand Salute" and the hold the salute until the casket is placed on the grave and the order is given "Two". The POIC then will call the Honor Guard to parade rest. After the clergyman completes the committal service and gives the POIC the signal to begin Military Honors, the POIC will call his detail to attention. The bugler will perform facing movements and march to a place predetermined during the rehearsal. The flag folders will perform facing movement and march to the head and foot of the casket and render hand salute. At this time the bugler will play taps. Upon completion of taps the flag folders will terminate the salute and begin to fold the flag. The POIC will present the flag to the next of kin. The POIC will give the final salute to the flag. The honor guard detail then will make appropriate facing movements and march away from the gravesite and return to their vehicle.

TWO PERSON DETAIL

The honor guard detail will arrive at a minimum of ½ hour prior to procession arrival at the cemetery or other predetermined location. The POIC will conduct a rehearsal of the honors to be performed. When the funeral coach arrives and the pallbearers remove the casket from the funeral coach, the POIC will call "Hand Salute" and the hold the salute until the casket is placed on the grave and the order is given "Two". The POIC then will call the Honor Guard to parade rest. After the clergyman completes the committal service and gives the POIC the signal to begin Military Honors, the POIC will call his detail to attention. The bugler will perform facing movements and march to a place predetermined during the rehearsal. At this time the bugler will play taps. Hand salute is rendered during the playing of taps. Upon completion of taps the POIC will terminate the hand salute. The bugler will place the bugle on a stand or table and return to the location of the POIC. The POIC and the bugler will perform facing movement and march to the head and foot of the casket and begin to fold the flag. The POIC will present the flag to the next of kin. The POIC will give the final salute to the flag. The honor guard detail then will make appropriate facing movements and march away from the gravesite and return to their vehicle. The bugler will retrieve the bugle from stand or table.
