FREE WASTE ANALYSIS

If your business, school or institution is located in **Baltimore City, Anne Arundel, Baltimore, Carroll, Harford, Howard** or **Montgomery Counties**, you may qualify for a *free* waste analysis that will help you establish or improve your recycling program. A recycling specialist will visit your site and make recommendations on how to best dispose of the particular type of waste generated by your organization.

REUSE DIRECTORY

Many organizations in the area will accept a wide range of used goods such as clothing, furniture, appliances, electronics, books and even pet supplies. The Reuse Directory lists all categories of reusable goods alphabetically and supplies the phone number for each listing. Call any of these numbers to make arrangements for either pick-up or delivery of your reusable items.

RECYCLING GUIDE

This three-part manual offers step-by-step instruction on how to start a recycling program or enhance an existing one. Part one explains how to establish a waste reduction program. Part two outlines an eight-step approach to office recycling. Part three explains how to implement a "Buy Recycled" program.

CONTRACT TRAINING MANUAL

Successful recycling requires a good working relationship between waste generators and waste processors. Contracts must be designed to meet the needs of both parties for effective and efficient long-term recycling. The newest feature of **mdrecycles.org** is the Contract Training Manual. It walks you through the process of developing fair contractual agreements and helps you avoid the most common pitfalls that can hinder your recycling program. The goal of this manual is to help recycling coordinators develop contracts that provide the best prices and service while allowing processors to make a reasonable profit.

RECYCLING VENDOR DIRECTORY

This directory is the most efficient tool available for locating the precise recycling service in your area for your particular needs. Click on a product category to find out who can process your bulk recyclable material. For example, select "Laser Toner Cartridges" and a list of recycling vendors will appear complete with contact name, address, phone number and a description of their service. All recycling company listings link to Mapquest so you can pinpoint their exact location.

RECYCLING CONTACTS

There are many organizations at the local, state and national level working to help you recycle. **mdrecycles.org** lists all of these organizations in an easy-to-use format. Simply click on the organization's icon and access the name, address and phone number of the office and person who can best answer your questions.

An important component of reducing waste is the process of buying recycled products. Many everyday products and supplies used by your organization can be purchased as recycled products. It's easy to begin buying recycled goods if you have the right resources.

mdrecycles.org offers specific resources by product category from Aluminum to Electronics to Vinyl ... and everything in between. There is also a listing of organizations that can help answer any of your questions about obtaining the recycled products you need.
