HIGHER AUTHORITY SHOULD FIND OUT ABOUT INCIDENTS VIA OUR OPERATIONAL REPORTING SYSTEM, NOT FROM PRESS REPORTS OR EMAILS RELAYED FROM FRIENDS AND FAMILY MEMBERS. WE MUST ENSURE INCIDENT REPORTING VOICE AND MESSAGE REQUIREMENTS, INCLUDING TIMELINESS AND ESSENTIAL REQUIREMENTS, ARE ROUTINELY ACHIEVED. REF A REMAINS GERMANE.

3. COMLANTFLT UNITS ARE DIRECTED TO REVIEW REF A AND ENSURE UNIT READINESS TO REPORT THE UNEXPECTED.
